About Scott D. Wiener:

In the Senate, Senator Wiener works to make housing more affordable, invest in our transportation systems, increase access to healthcare, support working families, meaningfully address climate change and the impacts of wildfires, reform our criminal justice system, reduce gun violence, reduce California's high poverty rate, and safeguard and expand the rights of all communities, including immigrants and the LGBTQ community. Senator Wiener has authored 42 bills that have been signed into law. Among them are SB 35, a landmark law to streamline housing approvals in cities not meeting their housing goals; and SB 855, which makes California the national leader in mental health and addiction care access by requiring insurance companies to cover all medically necessary mental health and substance use disorder treatments. Senator Wiener grew up in New Jersey, the son of a small business owner and a teacher, and attended public school. He received a bachelor's degree from Duke University and a law degree from Harvard Law School. He spent a year in Chile on a Fulbright Scholarship doing historical research. He haslived in San Francisco's Castro neighborhood since 1997.
